



## Tools & Supplies

Stamp Sets: Venetian Background

Ink: French Roast

Cardstock: Lemon Whip, Kraft

Die cutting machine

Short popcorn box die

1" circle punch

¼" super stick tape

⅛" hole punch

Seattle baker's cording

## Cutting Instructions

Kraft cardstock 2½" x 5" (scored at 2 ½")

Lemon Whip cardstock 5½" x 5 ½" (2 pieces for short popcorn box die cut)

## For project:

1. Stamp Venetian Background on Kraft cardstock piece in French Roast ink.
2. Score and fold Kraft cardstock piece at 2 ½" to create a "roof".
3. Die cut short popcorn box pieces (2) from Lemon Whip cardstock.
4. Locate where the box front and sides will be. Use a bone folder to score just below the scallops on both box "sides". This will create an approximately ¼" tab to adhere the roof to on both sides of the bird house.
5. Assemble the popcorn box, making sure the scored sides are opposite.
6. Locate the front of the box. Use a 1" circle punch to create an opening in the front.
7. Place a strip of ¼" super stick tape along the top of the scored sides. Bend slightly along score line and adhere roof to the box sides at a 45 degree angle.
8. Once roof is attached, carefully pinch together at top to punch a ⅛" hole.
9. Thread Seattle baker's cording through the holes and tie at top.
10. Fill bird house box with egg candies or other treats.
