Stamp Sets: Be My Valentine, Mini Blooms
Ink: Apple, Grass, Sugar, VersaMark
Cardstock: Seattle Petite Polka Dot Cardstock, Sage, Apple, Onyx
Die cutting machine
Small Pillow Box Die
¼" Super Stick Tape
Heart Doily
Static Magic
White Embossing Powder
Heat Tool
Be My Valentine Die Set
Mini Blooms Die Set
3D Foam Adhesive
Heart Twinkle Stickers

Cutting Instructions

Seattle Petite Polka Dot cardstock (for pillow box die cut – cut two) 4 ¼" x 5 ½"
Onyx cardstock 2 ¼" x 1 ¾"
Sage cardstock (for leaves die cut) 2 ¼" x 1"
Apple cardstock (for flower die cuts) 1 ¼" x 2 ¼"

For project:

1. Cut two Small Pillow Box Die Shapes from Seattle Petite Polka Dot Cardstock. Assemble with ¼" Super Stick Tape. TIP: You can get four entire Small Pillow Boxes from a sheet of cardstock making this a very cost effective workshop project.
2. Cut the center out of a Heart Doily and adhere to the Small Pillow Box as shown.
3. Prepare Onyx Cardstock with Static Magic then stamp "Happy Valentine's Day" image from Be My Valentine using VersaMark Ink. Add White Embossing Powder and heat emboss with Heat Tool. Set aside to cool. Tip: Bring a few clothespins for your workshop attendees to use as handles while embossing. That will keep everyone's fingers safe from burns.
4. Stamp leaves from Be My Valentine on a scrap of Sage Cardstock and die cut with matching dies.
5. Stamp two flowers from Mini Blooms on Apple Cardstock using Apple ink and die cut with matching die. Trim one of the flowers smaller and adhere on top of the full flower with 3D Foam Adhesive.
6. Trim the Happy Valentine's Day image down to size and glue to Small Pillow Box.
7. Embellish with stamped leaves, dimensional flower, and Cherry Heart Twinkle Stickers.
8. Pop open the Small Pillow Box, fill with treats and enjoy!
