Measurements

• Basic Black Cardstock

- 7-3/8 x 9-1/2", scored on the
 - 7-3/8" side at 1-1/4, 3-1/2, 4-3/4 and 7"
 - 9-1/2" side at 1-1/4 and 8-1/2"

• Basic White Cardstock

- scrap for stamping and punching a large and medium pumpkin, TWO stems, TWO leaves using the Pick of the Patch Bundle
- scrap for stamping and fussy cutting TWO crows using the Pick of the Patch Stamp Set
- scrap for punching a circle using the 2" Circle Punch
- Smoky Slate Cardstock
 - scrap for punching out an oval using the Double Oval Punch
- Pumpkin Pie or Starry Sky Cardstock
 - scrap for die cutting the tag-O reinforcer using the Tailor Made Tags Dies

• TWO - 2 x 7"


• scrap for die cutting the 1-9/16 x 3-5/16" tag using the Tailor Made Tags Dies

• Linen Thread

Instructions

- 1. Score, burnish, fold and trim the treat box according to the measurements using the template photo above for reference.
- 2. Adhere the TWO 2 x 7" pieces of designer paper to the treat box base using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Fold over the top of the treat box and assemble the box using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
- 3. Fill your treat box. I used <u>these Pumpkin Spice Biscotti from Amazon, CLICK HERE</u>. Wrap the Copper Clay ribbon around the top of the treat box and tie a big loopy bow.
- 4. Adhere the white circle to the tag using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Stamp the greeting on the Smoky Slate oval tag using Memento ink. Adhere the tag reinforcer on the right side of the oval using liquid glue. Use a <u>1/8" circle punch</u> to punch the Smoky Slate oval making it a tag.
- 5. Stamp the large pumpkin using Pumpkin Pie ink, the medium pumpkin using Copper Clay ink, the stems using Crumb Cake ink and the leaves using Old Olive ink. Punch out using the Pick of the Patch Builder Punch. Adhere the stems to the pumpkins, then adhere the completed pumpkins to the circle using liquid glue. Adhere the leaves to the tag using a Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
- 6.Stamp one crow using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Stamp the other crow using Starry Sky ink. Fussy cut the full black crow and just the body of the Starry Sky crow. Adhere together using liquid glue. Use the Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker to fill in the bird's eye. Fill in the bird's beak using a Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Write Marker. Adhere to the tag using a Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
- 7. Adhere the oval tag to the Tailor Made tag using Stampin' Dimensionals. Be sure that the thread holes of both tags line up.
- 8. Thread the Linen Thread through the hole in the tags from front to back, then thread the endunder the Copper Clay ribbon. Tie the tag on to the Copper Clay ribbon with the Linen Thread making a knot first then a big loopy bow.
