# Measurements

- **Basic Black Cardstock**
  - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - 4 x 5-1/4"
  - scrap for punching a circle using the 2-3/8" Circle Punch
  - scrap for stamping and punching or fussy cutting a large and small pumpkin, TWO stems, TWO leaves and TWO crows
- **Smoky Slate Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the 3/4 x 2-3/8" rectangle using the Countryside Corners Dies
- **Pumpkin Pie Cardstock**
  - scrap for punching a swoopy square using the Handmade Tag Punch
- **Starry Sky Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the "D" tag reinforcer using the Tailor Made Tags Dies
- **Them Bones Designer Series Paper**
  - THREE patterns of your choice - cut using modified Wonder Recipe #23
    - THREE 2 x 2-1/4"
- **Linen Thread**
  - 14"
- **3/8" Textured Ribbon - Copper Clay**
  - 5-1/2"



# Instructions

1. Score and burnish the card base using your Bone Folder. Emboss the card front using the Distressed Tile 3D Embossing Folder.
2. Cut the swoopy square in half, then adhere one of the halves to the back of the right side of one of the designer paper pieces using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere the designer paper, then the punched out circle using liquid glue.
3. Stamp the large pumpkin using Copper Clay ink, the small pumpkin using Pumpkin Pie ink, the stems using Crumb Cake ink and the leaves using Old Olive ink. Punch using the Pick of the Patch Builder Punch. Adhere the stems to the pumpkins, then adhere the completed pumpkins to the circle using liquid glue. Adhere the leaves to the pumpkin using a Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
4. Stamp one crow using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Stamp the other crow using Starry Sky ink. Fussy cut the full black crow and just the body of the Starry Sky crow. Adhere together using liquid glue. Use the Basic Black Stampin' Write Marker to fill in the bird's eye. Fill in the bird's beak using a Pumpkin Pie Stampin' Write Marker. Adhere to the card using a Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
5. Stamp the sentiment on the Smoky Slate rectangle with Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Adhere the Starry Sky tag reinforcer to the top left of the rectangle using liquid glue.
6. Fold the Copper Clay ribbon in half and tie the Linen Thread around it, then thread the tag reinforcer with the Linen Thread and make a bow.
7. Adhere the ribbon and sentiment piece to the card front using a combination of a Tear & Tape Adhesive and a Stampin' Dimensional.
8. Embellish with the Adhesive-Backed Sparkle Gems.
