
Measurements

• Blueberry Bushel Cardstock

- 6-3/4 x 7"
 - scored on the 7" side at 1/2, 1, 3-3/4 and 4-1/4"
 - scored on the 6-3/4" side at 1/2, 4-1/2 and 5"
- 1-5/8 x 2-5/8"

• Basic White Cardstock

- scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the blueberries using the Blueberry Bunches stamp set
- scrap for die cutting the second largest circle using the Everyday Details Dies
- scrap for die cutting the smallest banner using the Stylish Shapes Dies
- Granny Apple Green Cardstock
 - scrap for die cutting the leaves using the Lovely & Sweet Dies
- Vellum
 - scrap for die cutting the flowers using the Lovely & Sweet Dies
- Delightful Floral Designer Series Paper
 - 3/4 x 2-5/8"
 - 3-7/8 x 2-5/8"
- Starry Sky Metallic Woven Ribbon
 - about 28"





Instructions

- 1. Score, burnish with a Bone Folder, and trim the treat box according to the template photo and measurements above. **Tip:** Save the large scrap. Cut it down to the 1-5/8 x 2-5/8" piece that you need. Emboss and adhere to the flap using liquid glue.
- 2. Glue the strip of designer series paper to the larger panel and then wrap with ribbon. Tie a loopy bow and adhere to the front of the box. Cut a notch with a 2" circle punch then assemble the box using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
- 3. Fill the box with your favorite Kit Kat flavor. I used these <u>blueberry muffin flavor</u>.
- 4. Pop the white circle on to the box with dimensionals being careful not to glue the flap. The circle makes a tuck tab and holds the box closed.
- 5. Stamp the blueberries on Basic White Cardstock using Memento ink. Stamp the sentiment on the little label using Blueberry Bushel ink.
- 6. Watercolor the image with a water painter and Blueberry Bushel, Lemon Lime Twist and Granny Apple Green ink. Fussy cut. Adhere on the box with a combination of liquid glue and dimensionals.
- 7. Assemble the flower using Mini Glue Dots. Adhere it to the front of the sentiment label using a Mini Glue Dot. Adhere the leaves to the back of the sentiment label using a Mini Glue Dot. Pop it on the box using a combination of glue dots and dimensional.
- 8. Embellish with Rustic Metallic Dots.
