# Measurements

- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
  - 4-1/4 x 8-1/4", scored at 5-1/2"
  - 3 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the burger, fries and pickle using the Bistro Burger Bundle
  - scrap for die cutting a large tag using the Greetings of The Season Dies
  - scrap for die cutting the smallest clip corner rectangle using the Countryside Corners Dies
  - scrap for die cutting a banner using the Hearts & Hugs Dies
- **Basic Black Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the knife handle using the Bistro Burger Dies
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the wooden board using the Bistro Burger Dies
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the jalapeno using the Bistro Burger Dies
- **Mossy Meadow Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the jalapeno top using the Bistro Burger Dies
- **Silver Foil Sheets**
  - scrap for die cutting the knife blade using the Bistro Burger Dies
- **Take To The Sky Designer Series Paper**
  - 4 x 5-1/4"
  - scraps for die cutting the banners using the Bistro Burger Dies
- **Countryside Inn Designer Series Paper**
  - 4 x 2-1/2"
  - 3 x 8-1/2", scored on three sides at 3/8"
- **To Market Designer Series Paper**
  - scrap for die cutting the banners using the Bistro Burger Dies
- **Nature's Sweetness Specialty Designer Series Paper**
  - 4 x 2-1/2"
  - 2-3/4 x 4"
- **Linen Thread**

# Instructions

1. Cut and score the Pecan Pie card base and the Countryside Inn Designer Series Paper pocket pieces according to the template photo above. Burnish the score lines with a Bone Folder.
2. Adhere the remaining designer paper pieces to the small card and the large card base. Use the photos for pattern placement. Adhere the small card to the base.
3. Cut a large thumb notch out of the unscored end of the designer series paper pocket using a 2" Circle Punch. Fold in on the three score lines and adhere the pocket to the inside of the small card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the greetings on the tag, banner and clipped corner rectangle using Night of Navy ink.
5. Staple the long "CELEBRATE" banner with the Tiny Attacher and then glue the banner to the outside of the card.
6. Stamp the burger, fries and pickle on Basic White cardstock using Memento ink then color with Stampin' Blends. Die cut.
7. Adhere the wooden board die cut to the small card then trim off the left edge to make the board fit the width of the card. Cut up a second wooden board and use it's pieces to reinforce and clean up the inside of the card. Glue the wooden board pieces back to back inside the card and then trim the excess from the outside.
8. Wrap a piece of Linen Thread twice around the small card front and make a bow on the far left side. Wrap another piece of Linen twice around the tag and tie a knot on the back side.
9. Assemble the knife using liquid glue then slide it into the die cut slot on top of the burger. Adhere the fries to the card with liquid glue and the burger, knife and pickle with Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Adhere the banner flags to the tag and to the outside on the front of the of the small card.
11. Glue the tag inside of the small card and embellish with an industrial trinket.
12. Assemble the jalapeno using liquid glue and adhere it to the clipped corner rectangle using the same glue. Staple with the Tiny Attacher and then adhere the sentiment rectangle to the inside of the card.
