Measurements

• Basic Beige Cardstock

- o 6 x 10-1/4"
 - scored on the 10-1/4" side at 4-1/2 & 5-3/4"
- 4-1/2 x 7-7/8"
 - scored on the 7-7/8" side at 1/2, 1-3/4, 6-1/8 and 7-3/8"
 - scored on the 4-1/2" side at 1/2 & 1-3/4"
- o 5-3/8 x 3-1/4"
 - scored on the 5-3/8 side at 1/2 & 4-7/8"
 - scored on the 3-1/4" side at 1/2"
- 4 x 5-1/2"
- 4-3/8 x 3-3/4"

• Basic White Cardstock

 scraps for stamping and die cutting the ONE small layer cake and TWO large layer cakes, TWO cake plates, SIX leaves, TWO candles, THREE small, ONE medium and FOUR large flowers

• Very Vanilla Cardstock

o scraps for die cutting the scallop frame using the Wildflower Designs Dies

• Early Espresso Cardstock


- scraps for die cutting the hexagon using the scallop frame in the Wildflower Designs
 Dies
- scraps for die cutting the icing and layer frosting using the Cake Celebrations Dies

Instructions

- 1. Prepare the card box by scoring, burnishing and trimming the template pieces according to the measurements above. Refer to the template photo.
- 2. Emboss the 4 x 5-1/2" and 4-3/8 x 3-3/4" pieces of Basic Beige cardstock using the Modern Herringbone 3D Embossing Folder. Cut the 4-3/8 x 3-3/4" panel in half hot dog ways then distress the edges of the embossed panels using the edge of the Paper Snips Scissors.
- 3. Use a centering ruler to mark and punch half of a 1-1/2" circle making a large thumb notch on the two inside pockets. Adhere the completed pockets inside the cardholder using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
- 4. Glue one of the smaller embossed panels on each of the two pockets inside the the card keeper.
- 5. Wrap the ribbon around the closed card keeper and make a bow all the way to the right edge on the front of the box. Place Tear & Tape Adhesive over the ribbon to secure it. Adhere the embossed 4 x 5-1/2" piece to the front of the card keeper using lots of liquid glue to further secure the ribbon.
- 6. Adhere the designer paper to the front, as shown, using liquid glue. Adhere both the vanilla frame and espresso hexagon to the box using the same adhesive.
- 7. On Basic White cardstock, stamp and then die cut:
 - a. ONE small layer cake and ONE large layer cake using second generation Basic Beige ink for the cake and full strength of the same ink for the swipe
 - b. ONE large layer cake using second generation Wild Wheat ink for the cake and full strength of the same ink for the speckle
 - c.TWO cake plates using Pebbled Path ink
 - d. SIX leaves using Early Espresso ink
 - e. THREE small, ONE medium and FOUR large flowers using second generation Boho Blue ink for the flower and full strength of the same ink for the center detail
 - f.TWO candles using Misty Moonlight ink for the candles and Wild Wheat ink for the flames
- 8. Die cut the icing and layer frosting from Early Espresso cardstock while you are cutting the stamped images.
- 9. Assemble the cakes then glue the two layer beige cake to the front of the card box. Glue the one layer Wild Wheat cake to the inside pocket.
- 10. Glue the candles down with liquid glue and decorate the cakes with flowers and leaves using a combination of Mini Stampin' Dimensionals and Glue Dots.
- 11. Adhere one flower and leaf to the inside left pocket.
- 12. Embellish with In Color™ Opaque Sparkle Dots and Adhesive-Backed Dragonflies & Birds.
