Measurements

- **Two-Tone Cardstock - Old Olive or Mossy Meadow**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
 - 3-1/2 x 4-3/4"
- **Very Vanilla Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the daisy base and details using the Cheerful Daisies Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the third from the largest postage edge rectangle using the Perennial Postage Dies
- **Old Olive or Mossy Meadow Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting TWO leaves using the Cheerful Daisies Dies
- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
 - 3/8 x 3-1/8"
- **Floral Delight Designer Series Paper**
 - 1-1/4 x 3-1/2"
 - 3/4 x 4-1/2"
 - 1 x 4"
- **Daffodil Delight Satin Ribbon**
 - about 12"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Old Olive or Mossy Meadow Two-Tone Cardstock card base.
2. Emboss the 3-1/2 x 4-3/4" panel using the Starstruck Embossing Folder then sand the print off the embossed side using a fine sanding block.
3. Adhere the embossed panel, designer paper and pecan pie postage rectangle using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the bigger flower center on Pecan Pie cardstock using Pecan Pie ink then die cut.
5. Die cut TWO little flower centers then stamp them with the same stamp and ink to give them some texture.
6. Die cut the flower details from Very Vanilla cardstock with the Adhesive Sheets on the back making the details peel and stick - BONUS.
7. Adhere the flower details to the daisy base then adhere the daisy and leaves to the card using liquid glue.
8. Pop the flower centers on the daisies using some Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Stamp the sentiment on the Crumb Cake strip using Early Espresso then glue it to the card.
10. Make a big loopy bow using the Daffodil Delight Satin Ribbon and adhere it to the card using a rolled up Mini Glue Dot.
11. Embellish with Low-Profile Dots.
