Measurements

• Gray Granite Cardstock

- 8-1/2 x 4"
 - scored on the 8-1/2" side at 2, 4, 6 and 8"
 - scored on the 4" side at 2"

• Basic White Cardstock

- scrap for stamping and punching the mushroom cap and stem and for stamping and fussy cutting the ground and leaves using the Terrific Toadstool Bundle
- scrap for die cutting the smallest label using the Iconic Imagery Dies

Pool Party Cardstock

 scrap for die cutting the fourth from the smallest wonk-a-doodle circle using the Around It All Dies

• Daffodil Delight Cardstock


o scrap for die cutting a little flower using the Heart Shaped Dies

• Toadstool Garden Designer Series Paper

- o 3-/16 x 3-9/16"
 - scored all sides at 3/4"

• Linen Thread

o about 12"



Instructions

- 1. Score, fold and cut the Gray Granite cardstock box according to the template above. Burnish with a Bone Folder. Assemble the box using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
- 2. Score, fold and cut the designer series paper lid according to the template above. Burnish with a Bone Folder. Assemble the box top using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
- 3. Stamp the mushroom cap in your choice of Real Red or Azure Afternoon ink on Basic White Cardstock. Stamp the leaves and ground on the same white scrap using Granny Apple Green ink. Stamp the mushroom stem and sentiment on Basic White scraps using Early Espresso ink.
- 4. Punch the mushroom parts using the Toadstool Builder Punch. Fussy cut the ground and the leaves. Die cut the sentiment using the small label die from Iconic Imagery Dies.
- 5. Emboss the wonk-a-doodle circle with the embossing folder of your choice then glue the ground to the circle and cut off the excess. Pop the circle on the top of the box with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 6. Punch a 1/8" hole in the sentiment label. Thread the tag with Linen Thread and tie a big loopy bow.
- 7. Assemble the mushroom using liquid glue. Adhere the mushroom, leaves and tag to the box top using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 8. Shape the flower using the capped putty end of the Take Your Pick Tool and a Stampin' Pierce Mat.
- 9. Embellish with Opal Round dingle.


