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Measurements

- Pretty Peacock Cardstock
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- Basic White Cardstock
 - scrap for die cutting the 1 x 2-1/4" arched label using the Everyday Arches Dies
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the leaf and flower images using the Everyday You & Me Bundle
- Wild Wheat Cardstock
 - scrap for die cutting the 2-3/4" wonky circle using the Around it All Dies
- Everyday Happiness Designer Series Paper
 - $\circ~$ 3 x 4-1/4" with chicken lips cut out at the bottom
 - 3-7/8 x 1-1/2"
- Cream Woven Ribbon
 - about 9"



Instructions

• Squeeze Bottles - Amazon

- 1. Score, fold and burnish the Pretty Peacock card base using a Bone Folder. Stamp the word and splatter images from the Elements of Text Stamp Set on the card front using Pretty Peacock ink.
- 2. Emboss the Wild Wheat wonky circle using the Dashing Designs Embossing Folder.
- 3. Adhere the designer paper, followed by the wonky circle using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
- 4. Stamp the greeting on the arched label using Pretty Peacock ink.
- 5. Stamp the floral and leaf images on the scrap of Basic White cardstock using Pretty Peacock, Old Olive and Wild Wheat ink. Die cut and fussy cut.
- 6. Crinkle the layers of the Pretty Peacock large and small flowers, then assemble the blooms using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 7. Cut the Wild Wheat blooms off of the small flower and leaf images then glue them to the full image stamped with Old Olive ink. Paper piecing it to make TWO multicolor flower and leaf blooms.
- 8. Adhere the sentiment, floral and leaf images using a combination of liquid glue and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 9. Make a bow and adhere it to the card using a Mini Glue Dot.
- 10. Embellish with the Tiny Bee Trinkets and the Low Profile Dots.



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
