Measurements

- Basic Black Cardstock
 - o 8-3/8 x 9", scored on the
 - 8-3/8" side at 3/8, 3/4, 4-3/8 and 4-3/4"
 - 9" side at 3/8, 5-1/4 and 5-5/8"
 - o 1-1/2 x 9-1/2"
- Basic White Cardstock
 - scrap for stamping and punching a medium and small pumpkin, TWO stems, and a leaf using the Pick of the Patch Bundle
 - o 1-3/4" Circle
- Smoky Slate Cardstock
 - scrap for punching out the smallest rectangle using the Countryside Corners
 Dies
- Starry Sky or Pumpkin Pie Cardstock
 - o scrap for die cutting the "D" reinforcer using the Tailor Made Tags Dies
 - o scrap for punching out a tag using the Handmade Tag Punch
- Them Bones Designer Series Paper
 - o 1-1/4 x 3-1/2"
 - o 3-3/8 x 3-1/8"
 - o 3-3/8 x 4-5/8"
- Linen Thread
 - o about 14"
- 3/8" Textured Ribbon Copper Clay
 - o about 5-1/2"



Instructions

- 1. Prepare the Hot Cocoa Treat Box by scoring, folding and cutting according to the measurements and photograph provided. Before assembling your box, round the corners of the top portion of the box.
- 2. Round the bottom corners of the piece of designer series paper going on the closing flap, then adhere it to the flap using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere the designer series paper to the front of the box using the same glue. Cut a notch using a 2-3/8" Circle Punch.
- 3. Assemble the box using Tear & Tape Adhesive. Put your cocoa packet in the box.
- 4. Wrap the belly band around the box, then sharpen up the creases with a Bone Folder. Place Tear & Tape Adhesive on the ends of the belly band, remove the release paper and seal the belly band. Make sure it's tight enough that it doesn't fall off, but loose enough to slide.
- 5. Adhere the Handmade Tag and the the last piece of designer paper to the belly band using liquid glue.
- 6. Stamp the greeting on the Smoky Slate rectangle with Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Adhere the "D" reinforcer to the top left corner of the sentiment rectangle using liquid glue.
- 7. Fold the Copper Clay ribbon in half and tie the Linen Thread around it, then thread the tag reinforcer with the Linen Thread and make a bow.
- 8. Adhere the ribbon and sentiment piece to the card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
