## Measurements

- **Daffodil Delight Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the bee hive using the Fluffiest Friends Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for stamping and punching the bee's body, wings, antenna, and two hearts using the Bee My Valentine Bundle
  - scrap for punching the scalloped oval using the Double Oval Punch
  - scrap for die cutting the circle using the Radiating Stitches Dies
- **Basic Black Cardstock**
  - scrap for punching the smooth oval using the Double Oval Punch
- **Sweet Sorbet Bordered Ribbon**
  - about 18"

## Instructions

1. Emboss the die cut beehive with the Twisted Rope Embossing Folder. Use a Blending Brush to ink the edges of the embossed bee hive.
2. Adhere the smooth oval to the scalloped oval using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Then adhere the ovals to the beehive using the same adhesive and cut off the excess along the bottom of the hive.
3. Use a 1/2" circle punch to punch two holes in the beehive, one at the bottom and one at the top of the hive.
4. Stamp the bee body in Daffodil Delight ink, then stamp the bee's stripes and stinger, and face in Memento Black Ink on top of it's body. Stamp the antenna separately using the same ink.
5. Stamp the bee's wings by first stamping the inside of the wings with the 2nd generation technique using Pool Party ink. Then stamp the outline of the wings with full strength Pool Party ink.
6. Punch the bee pieces using the Bee Bulider punch and assemble it using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
7. Stamp the sentiment on the stitched circle using Memento Black Ink. Use a 1/8" hole punch to punch a hole in the top of the stitched circle and a
8. Slide two honey sticks through the holes in the beehive then adhere the assembled bee and two hearts to the bee hive using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Wrap the ribbon around the honey sticks then thread it through the hole in the stitched circle and tie a bow.
10. Brush some Wink of Stella on the bee's wings.
