# Measurements

- **Pool Party Cardstock**
  - 4-5/8" circle scored at 2 & 2-3/4" using the 4th largest of the Deckled Circle Dies
  - 3/4 x 3-1/8", scored at 3/4 & 2-3/8"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for stamping and punching out the bee, the large heart and a small heart from the Bee My Valentine Bundle
  - 1/2 x 2" with chicken lips on the right side
- **Sweet Sorbet 1/4" Bordered Ribbon**
  - about 9"

# Instructions

1. Find center on the Pool Party circle then score 3/8" right and 3/8" left of center. Burnish with a Bone Folder. Emboss the front and back of the lip balm holder with the Softly Sophisticated Embossing Folder.
2. Use your Bone Folder to lightly curl the 3/4" strip of Pool Party. You are curling between the score lines. Fold the score lines and make a "D" and glue the ends together with Tear & Tape Adhesive. Use a little more Tear & Tape Adhesive to attach the loop inside of the holder between the score lines. Slide the lip balm inside the loop and pop the fuzzy bee on with a Mini Glue Dot.
3. Stamp the sentiment on the white 1/2" strip with Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Punch a 1/8" hole on the left side. Cut chicken lips on the right side. Thread the hole with ribbon and tie a bow. Attach the tag to the clip using a Mini Glue Dot.
4. Stamp the bee's body on Basic White Cardstock with Daffodil Delight ink, then stamp his stripes and face with Memento ink. Punch out using the Bee Builder Punch.
5. Stamp the bee's antennae on a white scrap using Memento ink. Punch out using the small heart on the Bee Builder Punch.
6. Stamp the wings by first stamping the outline of the wings with full strength Pool Party ink, then stamp the inside fill of the wings with second generation Pool Party ink. Punch out the wings with the large heart on the Bee Builder Punch.
7. On another scrap of Basic White Cardstock, stamp the large and small hearts with Sweet Sorbet ink. Punch using the Bee Builder Punch.
8. Assemble the bee using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere the bee and hearts to the holder using Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Close the holder with a clip.
10. Embellish with a bit of Wink of Stella on the wings and a couple of Adhesive Backed Heart & Flowers.
