### Measurements

#### • Smoky Slate Cardstock

- o 8-1/2 x 11", scored at:
  - 11" side: 1/2, 2-1/4, 5-3/4 and 7-1/2", rotate 90 degrees to the right
  - 8-1/2" side: 1-3/4 and 7-3/4"
- scrap for die cutting the tag using the Merriest Trees Dies

#### • Basic White Cardstock

- scrap to stamp and die cut the medium airplane using the Adventurous Sky Bundle
- o scrap for die cutting the sentiment banner using the Adventurous Sky Bundle

#### Night of Navy Cardstock

- o scrap for die cutting the sign attachment using the Adventurous Sky Dies
- o scrap to die cut a tag reinforcer using the Merriest Trees Dies

#### Take to the Sky Designer Series Paper

- o TWO 3-1/4 x 5-3/4"
- o TWO 1-1/2 x 5-3/4"
- o 2 x 5-1/2" with chicken lips on both ends
- o scrap for die cutting the tag using the Merriest Trees Dies

#### • 3/8" Textured Ribbon

TWO pieces about 8" each

#### Linen Thread

o about 30"



### Instructions

- 1. Score, cut and burnish the Smoky Slate Cardstock according to the template. Mark 3/4" from either score of the front and back panels and punch a 1/4" hole for your ribbon handles.
- 2. Add Tear & Tape Adhesive as pictured, slide ribbon into place for handles. Add more Tear & Tape Adhesive over the ends of the ribbon to secure. Fold the top edge down, securing the ribbon and finishing the top edge.
- 3. Adhere the designer series paper to the front, back and side panels of the bag using liquid glue, then glue the  $2 \times 5-1/2$ " piece of designer paper to the front panel.
- 4. Assemble the bag and add your treats. This bag fits two movie theater boxes of candy perfectly.
- 5. On the Smoky Slate tag, stamp the clouds and the sentiment in Night of Navy ink and color in the clouds with the white pencil from the Watercolor Pencils Assortment 1 set.
- 6. Adhere the two tags together with liquid glue. Fold and adhere the Night of Navy tag reinforcer to the top of the tags using the same adhesive.
- 7. Fold the Linen Thread in half, then thread it through the tags. Make two large knots to hold it in place. Cut the thread and continue to make several additional knots up to the top of the Linen Thread. Tie the Linen Thread around the ribbon handle. Secure the tags to the bag using Stampin' Dimensionals. Embellish with an Industrial Trinket adhered with a Mini Glue Dot.
- 8. Stamp the medium airplane with Tuxedo Black Memento ink on a Basic White scrap. Water color the plane with the ink and a water painter. When dry, die cut the plane.
- 9. Stamp the sentiment with Night of Navy ink on the Basic White sentiment banner. Adhere the banner to the sign attachment, then to the airplane with liquid glue. Pop the plane on to the tags with Stampin' Dimensionals.
