Instructions

- 1. Score the card base and burnish with a Bone Folder. Tap the embossing buddy from the Embossing Additions Tool Kit onto the card.
- 2. Stamp the background element with Versamark. Pour the clear embossing powder from the Basics Embossing Powders over the image, then pour the excess back into the container. Hold the card with the reverse tweezers from the Embossing Additions Tool Kit and carefully heat with the Heat Tool.
- 3. Stamp the sentiment using Night of Navy ink on Basic White Cardstock then die cut using the the largest cloud die.
- 4. Punch a 1/8" hole in the top of the tag center. Thread the hole with Linen thread and make a knot with about an inch overhanging it. Shape the thread and secure it at the knot with a Mini Glue Dot.
- 5. Adhere the designer paper and tag to the card front with Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Adhere the three clouds using the same adhesive.
- 6. Assemble the airplane using liquid glue. Adhere to the card front using the same adhesive.
- 7. Embellish with an Industrial Trinket using a Mini Glue Dot.
