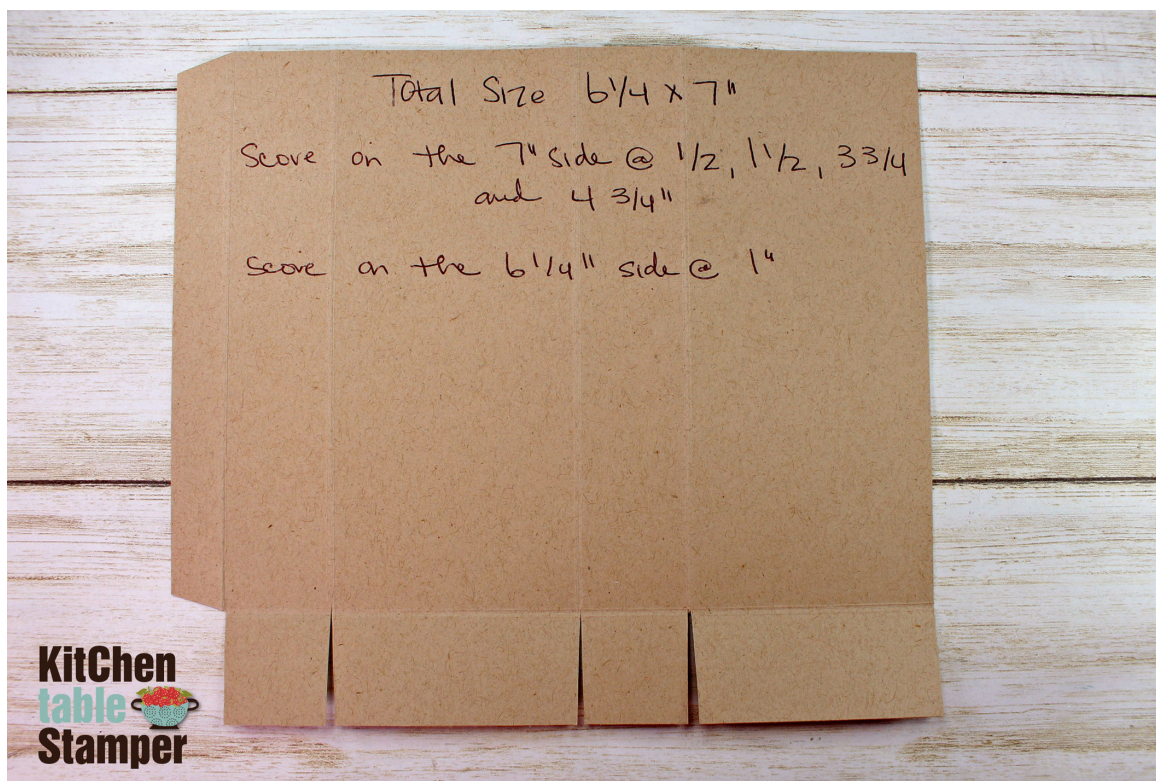

Measurements

- **Real Red or Garden Green Cardstock**
 - 6-1/4 x 7"
 - scored on the 7" side at 1/2, 1-1/2, 3-3/4, and 4-3/4"
 - then rotate one turn to the right and score at 1" on the 6-1/4" side
- **Real Red Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a partial tag using the Greetings of the Season Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the large tag using the Merriest Trees Dies
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting a tree, trunk and star using the Merriest Trees Stamp Set and Dies
 - scrap for die cutting a partial tag using the Greetings of the Season Dies
- **Reindeer Days Designer Series Paper**
 - TWO 2 x 5"
- **Red & White Baker's Twine**
 - about 24" folded in half

Instructions

1. Score, burnish with a Bone Folder, and trim the Real Red or Garden Green cardstock according to the template photo and measurements above.
2. Adhere the designer series paper to the front and back of the bag then assemble the bag using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
3. Score the large white tag 2" from the flat end and then fold on the score. Adhere the portion of tag with the flat end to the back of the treat bag. Fill the bag with treats then pinch the bag to make a gusset fold at the top. Fold the tag over the top of the bag and clip closed with a snowflake clothes pin.
4. Embellish the snowflake clothes pin with a Red & White Peppermint.
5. Stamp the tree on Basic White cardstock using Garden Green ink. Stamp the trunk on Basic White cardstock using Pecan Pie ink. Stamp the star on Basic White cardstock using Daffodil Delight ink. Die cut.
6. Stamp the greeting on Basic White cardstock using Pecan Pie ink. Die cut the sentiment using the long thin oblong tag from Greetings of the Season Dies.
7. Stack the sentiment tag and the Real Red oblong tag and trim the length using a paper trimmer. Glue the sentiment tag to the Real Red tag offset so that you can see the red color behind the white tag.
8. Use a floss threader and thread a double length of baker's twine through the hole in the bag flap and then through the tag back to front. Tie the tag onto the bag and secure it with a bit of Stampin' Dimensional.
9. Pop the tree and trunk on to the bag using Stampin' Dimensionals, then pop the star on the tree using more of the same adhesive.
