Measurements

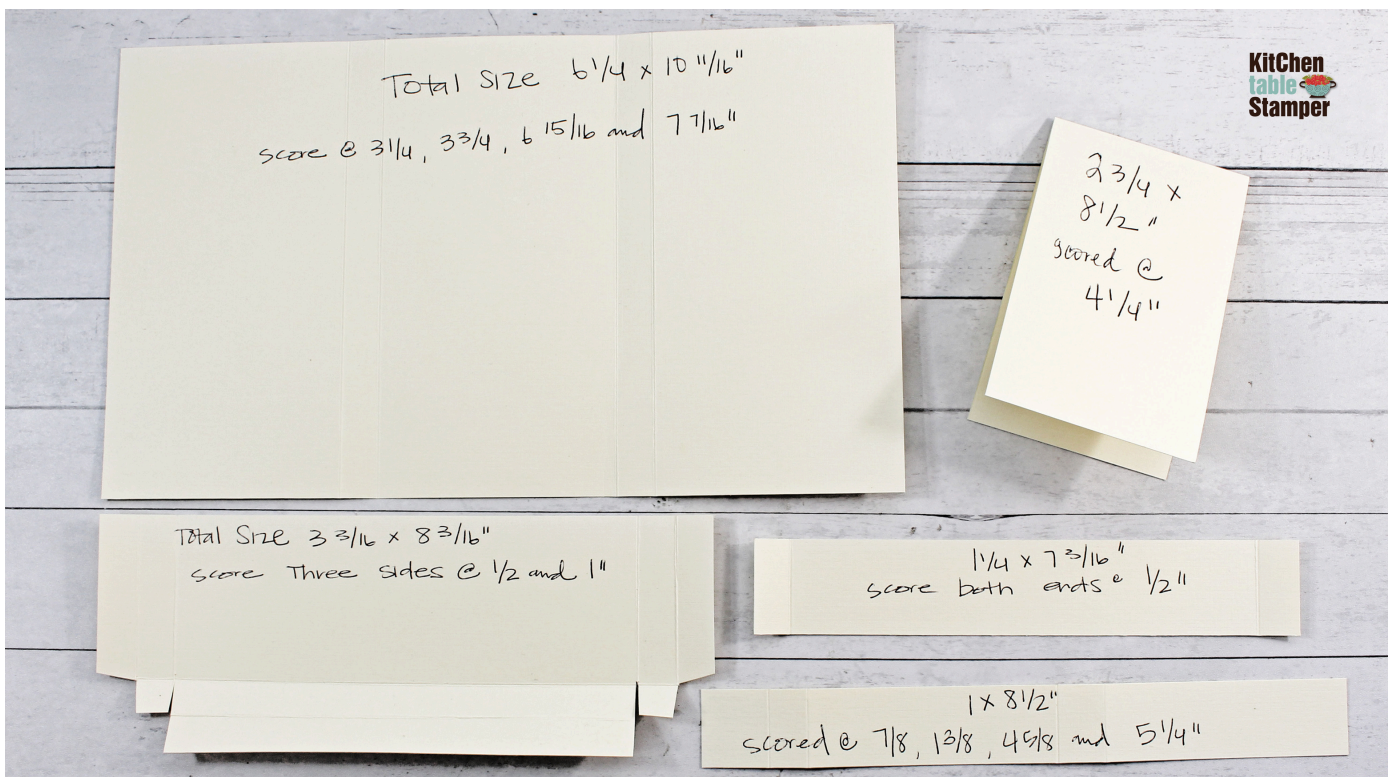
- **Garden Green Cardstock**
 - 6-1/4 x 10-11/16 scored at 3-1/4, 3-3/4, 6-15/16 and 7-7/16
 - 2-3/4 x 8-1/2" scored at 4-1/4"
 - 3-3/16 x 8-3/16 scored on three sides at 1/2 and 1"
 - 1-1/4 x 7-3/16" scored at 1/2" on both ends
 - 1 x 8-1/2" scored at 7/8, 1-3/8, 4-5/8 and 5-1/4"
 - scrap for die cutting TWO holly leaves, TWO wreaths, and a ribbon using the Reindeer Fun Dies
 - scrap for die cutting a second from the largest rectangle using the Nested Essentials Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a 2" circle using the Deckled Circle Dies
 - scrap for die cutting THREE 1-3/8" decorative circles using the Spotlight on Nature Dies
 - scrap for die cutting a 2 x 2-3/4" and 1-1/2 x 2-1/4" rectangle using the Perennial Postage Dies
- **Real Red Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting FOUR holly berries, TWO bows, and a present using the Reindeer Fun Dies
- **Pool Party Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting THREE of the largest chicken lips banners using the Nested Essentials Dies
 - scrap for die cutting THREE of the largest squares using the Perennial Postage Dies
- **Granny Apple Green Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting TWO holly leaves using the Reindeer Fun Dies
- **Pecan Pie, Basic Beige and Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - scraps for die cutting TWO of each of the deer pieces using the Reindeer Fun Dies
- **Reindeer Days Designer Series Paper**
 - SIX - 3 x 6"
 - 1 x 6"
 - 2 x 6"
 - 2-1/2 x 4"
 - 1 x 2-3/4"
- **Real Red & Gold Dotted Ribbon**
 - about 20"
 - about 6"

Portfolio Instructions

1. Score and burnish all the template pieces with a Bone Folder and then trim the pocket piece according to the measurements above and template photo below.
2. Use Tear & Tape Adhesive to assemble the pocket, then adhere the pocket to the inside of the portfolio using the same adhesive. Be sure that you are adhering it to the 3-3/16" section of the portfolio.
3. Adhere the strap to the inside of the portfolio. Be sure that you are adhering it to the 3-1/4" section of the portfolio.
4. Adhere THREE of the 3 x 6" designer series papers to the inside panels of the portfolio using liquid glue. Adhere the 1 x 6" piece of designer paper to the strap and the 2 x 6" piece to the pocket using the same adhesive.
5. Turn to the outside of the portfolio and adhere the remaining 3 x 6" designer series papers to the outside panels of the portfolio using liquid glue.
6. Fold up the portfolio and wrap the belly band around. Secure the belly band with Tear & Tape Adhesive. Wrap the belly band with Red & Gold Dotted Ribbon and tie a big loopy bow.
7. Stamp the "...Better Together" greeting on the deckled circle and the "...Filled with Warmth" greeting on the larger postage rectangle using Garden Green ink.
8. Trim the Granny Apple Green holly and adhere them to the circle using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere the deckled circle to the outside of the belly band using more dimensionals. Adhere the chicken lips banner to the inside of the belly band using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
9. Assemble a deer, present and holly using liquid glue. Adhere the deer and present to the 1-3/8" decorative circles, then adhere the circles to the Pool Party postage squares. Adhere the postage squares inside the portfolio, one on the strip and one on the pocket.
10. Adhere a Pool Party chicken lips banner to the center section of the portfolio followed by the inside greeting and holly using liquid glue.



Gift Card Holder Instructions

1. Adhere the 2-1/2 x 4" pieces of designer series paper to the card front and adhere the pierced rectangle to the inside of the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. When gluing the pierced rectangle, keep in mind that this is a gift card pocket. Put liquid glue only at the very edge of the two short sides and the bottom edge.
2. Adhere the 1 x 2-3/4" piece of designer series paper to the inside using the same adhesive.
3. Assemble a deer then adhere the deer to the 1-3/8" decorative circle. Adhere the circle to the Pool Party postage square, then adhere the square to the pocket inside the card. Be sure to keep the glue on the bottom half of the square as to not glue your pocket closed.
4. Stamp the "Merry Christmas" greeting on the smaller postage rectangle using Garden Green ink.
5. Adhere the Pool Party banner with chicken lips to the card front using liquid glue.
6. Fold the ribbon in half and secure it with a Mini Glue dot. Adhere the greeting with Tear & Tape Adhesive sandwiching the ribbon between the layers.
7. Adhere the holly with liquid glue and the berries with a Mini Stampin' Dimensional.
