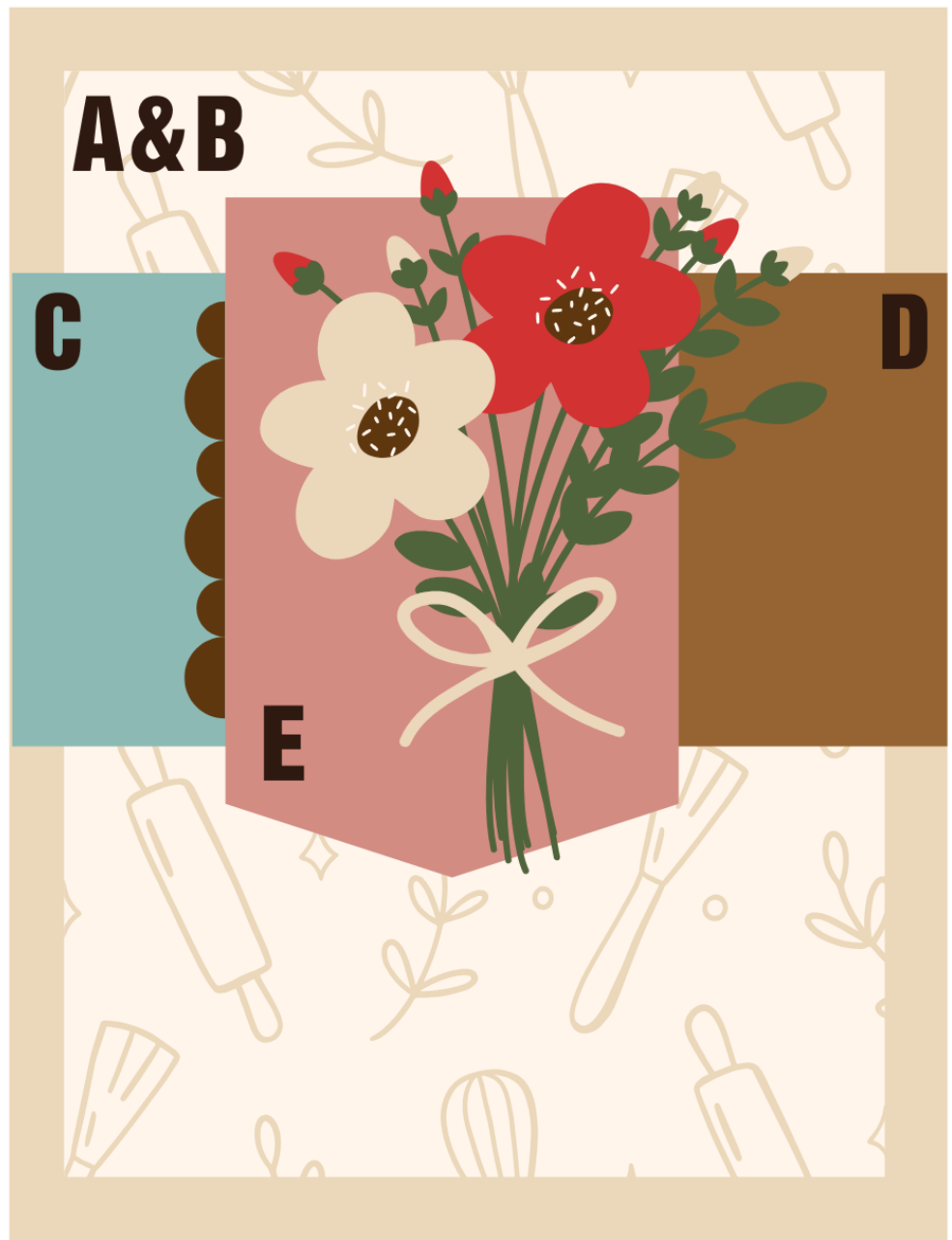


Short Cut Card Sketch #13

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Cake Celebration Card 1

Cool People Exclusive Card Sketch #13



Measurements

- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
 - 3-3/4 x 5"
- **Very Vanilla Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the hexagon tag using the Greetings of the Season Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the cake, platter and flowers using the Cake Celebrations Bundle
- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the scalloped hexagon frame using the Wildflower Designs Dies
- **Wildly Flowering Designer Series Paper**
 - 3 x 3"
 - 1-1/2 x 3"
- **Wild Wheat Rustic Striped Ribbon**
 - about 8"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Basic Beige card base using a Bone Folder.
2. Emboss the 3-3/4 x 5" panel of Basic Beige using the Modern Herringbone Embossing Folder. Use your Paper Snips Scissors to distress the edges, adhere it to the card, followed by the designer paper using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Cut off the long sides of the Early Espresso scalloped frame then adhere one of the straight pieces to the left side of the Very Vanilla hexagon tag using liquid glue. Reserve the remaining hexagon pieces for more cards. Adhere the tag to the card using the same adhesive.
4. Stamp the cake twice, one above the other, using second generation Wild Wheat ink on Basic White cardstock. Using the same ink, full strength this time, stamp the layer or spatter frosting on the cake.
5. Stamp the different flowers using second generation Moody Mauve ink on Basic White cardstock. Using the same ink, full strength this time, stamp the flower center.
6. Stamp the leaves using Early Espresso ink. Stamp the platter using Pebbled Path ink. Die cut the cake, flowers, leaves and platter.
7. Assemble the cake using liquid glue then adhere it to the Very Vanilla tag. Decorate the cake with flowers and leaves using a combination of Mini Stampin' Dimensionals and Mini Glue Dots.
8. Make a bow with the Wild Wheat ribbon and adhere it using a Mini Glue Dot.
9. Embellish using the Adhesive-Backed Dragonflies & Birds and 2023-2025 In Color Opaque Sparkle Dots.





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Cake Celebration Card 2



Measurements

- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
 - 3-3/4 x 5"
- **Very Vanilla Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the hexagon using the Wildflower Designs Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the cake, platter, leaves and flowers using the Cake Celebrations Bundle
- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the scalloped hexagon frame using the Wildflower Designs Dies
 - scrap for die cutting the the icing and layer frosting using the Cake Celebrations Dies
 - scrap for die cutting the small stitched oval using Changing Leaves Dies
- **Moody Mauve Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the flag banners using the Cake Celebrations Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the flag banners posts using the Cake Celebrations Dies
- **Wildly Flowering Designer Series Paper**
 - THREE 1-1/2 x 3"
- **Wild Wheat Rustic Striped Ribbon**
 - about 8"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Basic Beige card base using a Bone Folder.
2. Emboss the 3-3/4 x 5" panel of Basic Beige using the Modern Herringbone Embossing Folder. Use your Paper Snips Scissors to distress the edges, adhere it to the card, followed by the designer paper using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Fold the Early Espresso stitched oval in half then adhere it to the end of the Very Vanilla hexagon using liquid glue. Adhere the hexagon to the card followed by the Early Espresso scalloped angles using the same adhesive. Use the scalloped piece already prepared if you cut the Early Espresso decorative hexagon in advance. Reserve any remaining hexagon pieces for more cards.
4. Stamp the cake twice, one above the other, using second generation Moody Mauve or Wild Wheat ink on Basic White cardstock. Using the same ink, full strength this time, stamp the layer or spatter frosting on the cake.
5. Stamp the different flowers using second generation Wild Wheat or Moody Mauve ink on Basic White cardstock. Using the same ink, full strength this time, stamp the floral center.
6. Stamp the leaves using Pecan Pie ink. Stamp the platter using Pebbled Path ink. Die cut the cake, Early Espresso frosting, flowers, leaves and platter.
7. Assemble the cake using liquid glue then adhere it to the card. Adhere the Early Espresso icing and layers using liquid glue. Decorate the cake with flowers and leaves using a combination of Mini Stampin' Dimensionals and Mini Glue Dots.
8. Cut the Moody Mauve flag banner away from the poles then adhere the flags to the Pecan Pie die cut. Adhere the banner to the card on top of the cake using liquid glue.
9. Make a bow with the Wild Wheat ribbon and adhere it using a Mini Glue Dot.
10. Embellish using the Adhesive-Backed Dragonflies & Birds and 2023-2025 In Color Opaque Sparkle Dots.





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Cake Celebration Card 3



Measurements

- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
 - 3-3/4 x 5"
- **Very Vanilla Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the scalloped framed hexagon using the Wildflower Designs Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the cake, platter, candles, leaves and floral images using the Cake Celebrations Bundle
- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the scalloped hexagon frame and the layered frosting using the Wildflower Designs Dies
- **Wildly Flowering Designer Series Paper**
 - TWO 1-1/2 x 3" floral design
 - 1-1/2 x 3" neutral design
- **Wild Wheat Rustic Striped Ribbon**
 - about 8"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Basic Beige card base using a Bone Folder.
2. Emboss the 3-3/4 x 5" panel of Basic Beige using the Modern Herringbone Embossing Folder. Use your Paper Snips Scissors to distress the edges, adhere it to the card, followed by the designer paper using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Adhere the Very Vanilla scalloped hexagon frame followed by the Early Espresso label using liquid glue.
4. Stamp the cake twice, one above the other, using second generation Basic Beige ink on Basic White cardstock. Using the same ink, full strength this time, stamp the long swipe frosting for the bottom portion of the cake, and the short swipe frosting for the top portion of the cake.
5. Stamp the different flowers using second generation Moody Mauve ink on Basic White cardstock. Using the same ink, full strength this time, stamp the floral center.
6. Stamp the leaves using Pecan Pie ink. Stamp the platter using Pebbled Path ink. Stamp the candles using Moody Mauve ink. Stamp the candle flames using Wild Wheat ink. Paint over the flames using the Wink of Stella glitter brush.
7. Die cut the cake, flowers, candles, leaves and platter. Assemble the cake using liquid glue then adhere it to the card. Adhere the candles and Early Espresso icing and layers using liquid glue. Decorate the cake with flowers and leaves using a combination of Mini Stampin' Dimensionals and Mini Glue Dots.
8. Make a bow with the Wild Wheat ribbon and adhere it using a Mini Glue Dot.
9. Embellish using the Adhesive-Backed Dragonflies & Birds and 2023-2025 In Color Opaque Sparkle Dots.





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Cake Celebration Card 4



Measurements

- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 X 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
 - 3-3/4 x 5"
- **Very Vanilla Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the dotted hexagon tag using the Greetings of the Season Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the cake, platter and flower images using the Cake Celebrations Bundle
- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the scalloped hexagon frame using the Wildflower Designs Dies
- **Wildly Flowering Designer Series Paper**
 - 3 x 3"
 - 1-1/2 x 3"
- **Wild Wheat Rustic Striped Ribbon**
 - about 8"

Instructions

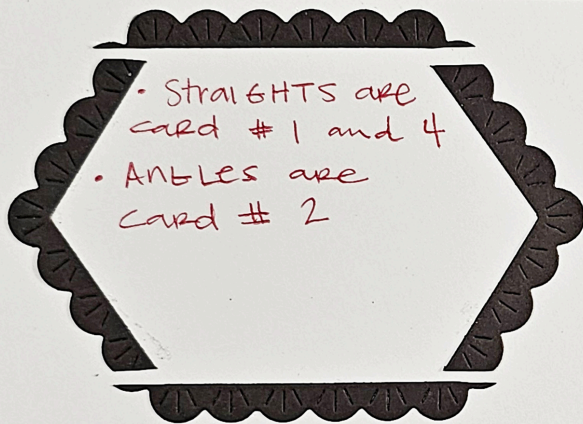
1. Score, fold and burnish the Basic Beige card base using a Bone Folder.
2. Emboss the 3-3/4 x 5" panel of Basic Beige using the Modern Herringbone Embossing Folder. Use your Paper Snips Scissors to distress the edges, adhere it to the card, followed by the designer paper using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.

6. Stamp the leaves using Early Espresso ink. Stamp the platter using Pebbled Path ink. Die cut the cake, flowers, leaves and platter.
7. Assemble the cake using liquid glue then adhere it to the Very Vanilla tag. Decorate the cake with flowers and leaves using a combination of Mini Stampin' Dimensionals and Mini Glue Dots.
8. Make a bow with the Wild Wheat ribbon and adhere it using a Mini Glue Dot.
9. Embellish using the Adhesive-Backed Dragonflies & Birds and 2023-2025 In Color Opaque Sparkle Dots.
