Turtle-y Tiny Treat Box

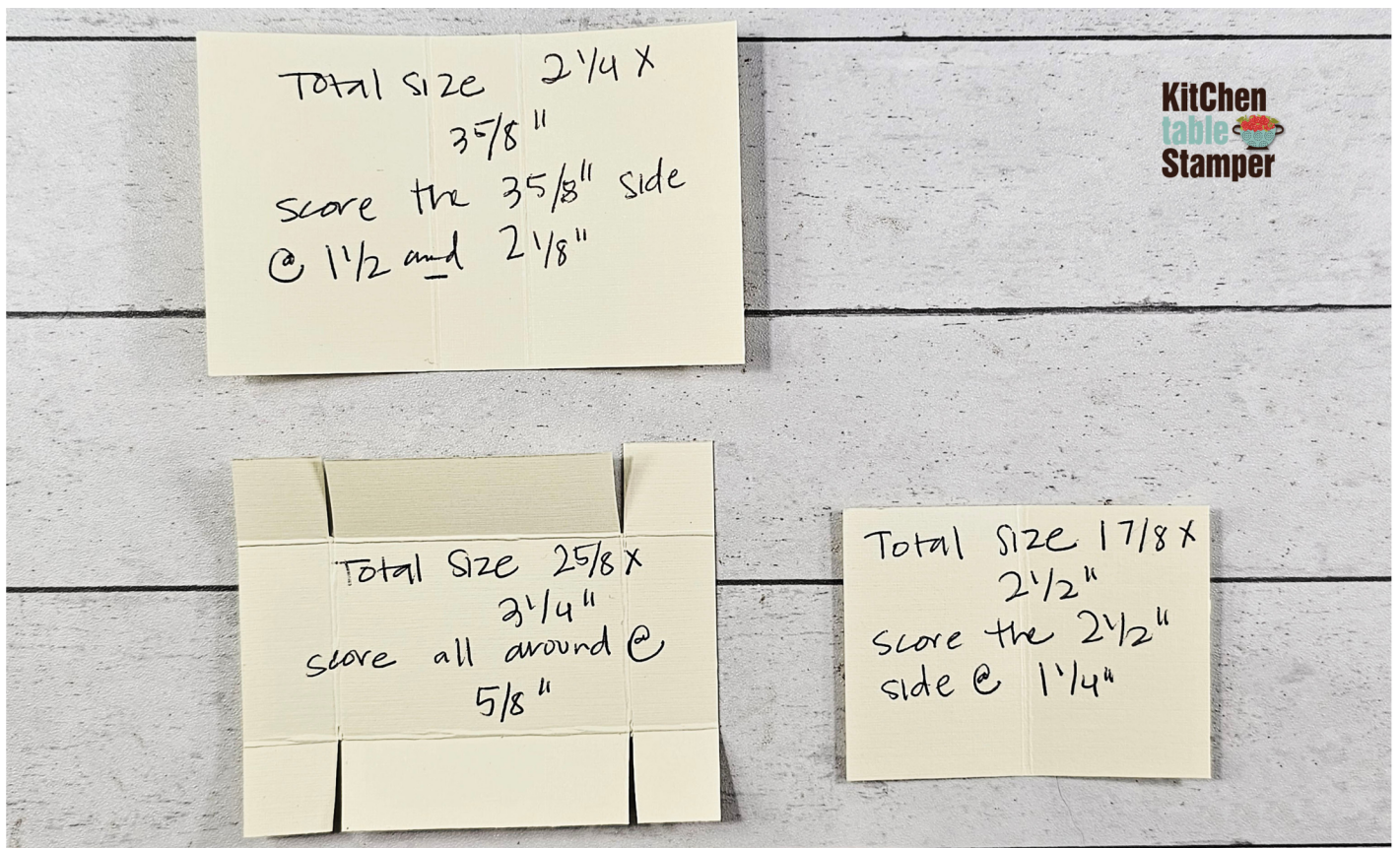

Measurements

- **Garden Green Cardstock**
 - 2-1/4" x 3-5/8"
 - Scored on the 3-5/8" side at 1-1/2 and 2-1/8"
 - 1 x 5-1/2"
- **Soft Sea Foam Cardstock**
 - 2-5/8" x 3-1/4"
 - Scored all around at 5/8"
 - 1-7/8" x 2-1/2"
 - Scored on the 2-1/2" side at 1-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the turtle using the Turtle-y Awesome Bundle
 - scrap for die cutting a chicken lips banner and oblong piece using the More Messages Die
 - 1-3/4 x 1-1/8"
- **Turtle-Y Cute Designer Series Paper**
 - 2-1/8 x 1-3/8"
 - TWO 1-3/4 x 1-1/8"
 - 3/4 x 5-1/2"
- **Shaded Spruce & Soft Sea Foam Ribbon**
 - about 10", cut the decorative edges off

Instructions

1. Score the box pieces and tiny card then burnish with a Bone Folder. Trim the treat box according to the template photo and assemble using Tear & Tape. Adhere the box inside the wrapper using the same adhesive.
2. Adhere the designer paper to the top of the box, the belly band and the front of the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Reserve one of the 1-3/4 x 1-1/8" pieces for the inside of the little card. Don't glue that one on yet.
3. Stamp the greetings from the Turtle-y Awesome stamp set on to the More Messages die cuts using Shaded Spruce ink. Adhere the chicken lips banner sentiment to the outside of the little card using Stampin' Dimensionals.
4. Stamp the inside greeting on the 1-3/4 x 1-1/8" white cardstock using a combination of Memento Tuxedo Black and Shaded Spruce ink. Stamp the hearts on the same panel using Strawberry Slush ink. Adhere the panel to the inside of the little card using liquid glue.
5. Punch two little holes in the front of the card where you want to tie the turtle. Thread one of the ribbon pieces through the holes and tie a bow to secure the turtle. Adhere the last piece of designer paper, covering the ribbon and holes inside of the little card, using liquid glue.
6. Stamp the turtle image on a scrap of Basic White cardstock and color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut.
7. Put the little card inside the box, close the box and wrap with the belly band. Sharpen the creases on the belly band with a Bone Folder then wrap the box again and secure the belly band using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
8. Adhere the turtle image to the belly band using Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Adhere the oblong greeting to the turtle using liquid glue.
10. Tie a bow with the remaining ribbon and adhere it and a little flower to the outside greeting using Mini Glue Dots.
11. Embellish using Holographic Resin Dots.
