

Measurements

- **Basic Gray Cardstock**
 - 4 x 11"
 - scored on both 4" sides at 1"
 - scored on the 11" side at 3, 4, 8 & 9"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a tag using the Everyday Arches dies
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the dog using the Spooky Halloween Bundle
 - scrap die cutting an oblong tag using the More Messages Dies
- **Basic Black Cardstock**
 - scrap scrap for die cutting a tag reinforcer using the Merriest Trees Dies
 - scrap for die cutting a bat and a fence using the Spooky Halloween Dies
- **Crushed Curry Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching a crescent moon using the 1-3/4" Circle Punch
- **Spooky Sweet Designer Series Paper**
 - front lid: 1-7/8 x 1-7/8"
 - lid top: 7/8 x 1-7/8"
 - lid sides: TWO 7/8 x 1-7/8"
 - back panel: 1-7/8 x 3-7/8"
 - front: 1-7/8 x 2-7/8"
 - front sides: TWO 7/8 x 2-7/8"
 - tag: 1/2 x 1-7/8"
- **Petunia Pop Ribbon**
 - about 9"
- **Linen Thread**
 - about 8"



Instructions

1. Score, fold, and burnish the Basic Gray treat box base according to the measurements above. Trim according to the template. Assemble the box using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
2. Adhere the designer papers to the box and tag using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Mask and stamp the word “SWEETS” on the right side of the white oblong using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Trim the length off of the left side and then punch a 1/8" hole on the right side using the using the Hole Punch Assortment.
4. Stamp the dog on white cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Die cut.
5. Adhere the tag reinforcer to the top of the arched tag using liquid glue. Punch a 1/8" hole through the tag using the same 1/8" circle punch.
6. Adhere the tag to the box lid using Stampin' Dimensionals then close the box with a Velcro dot.
7. Make a bow using the Petunia Pop ribbon adhere it to the box using a Mini Glue Dot.
8. Punch a crescent moon then punch a 1/8" hole in the top making it a tag. Glue the “SWEETS” tag to the moon.
9. Thread the Linen Thread, front to back, through the hole on the sentiment tag and moon then through the hole at the top of the tag. Using a Mini Stampin' Dimensional, secure the moon to the tag on the box then tie a thread knot and trim the excess Linen Thread
10. Adhere the fence to the tag using liquid glue. Adhere the dog using Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere the bat using a Mini Glue Dot.
11. Embellish using the Holographic Resin Dots.
