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Sweet & Spooky Play-Doh Treat

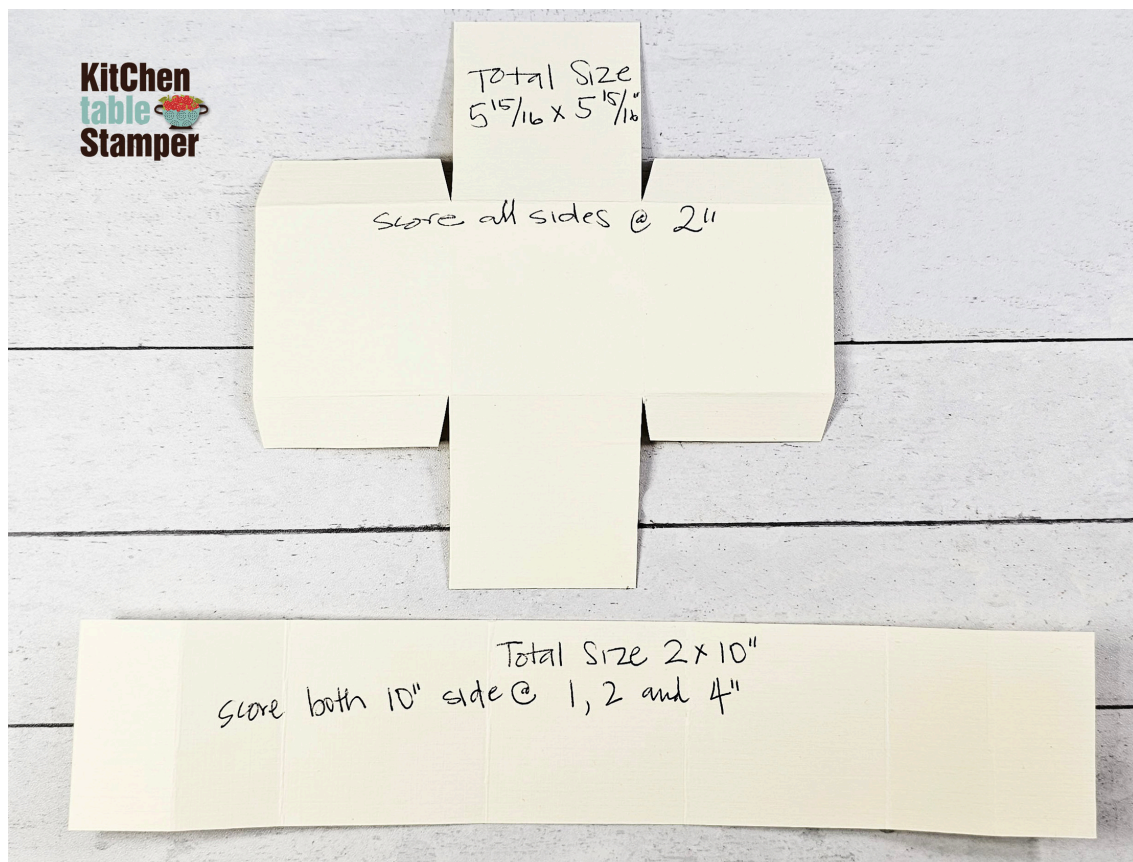

Measurements

- **Basic Black Cardstock**
 - 5-15/16 x 5-15/16"
 - scored at 2" on all four sides
 - 2 x 10"
 - scored on BOTH 10" sides at 1, 2 and 4"
 - scrap for die cutting a web section using the Fright Night Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the pumpkin using the Party Celebrations Stamp Set
- **Spooky & Sweet Kit**
 - bat and pumpkin die cuts
 - Bubble Bath tag with "trick or TREAT"
 - Pumpkin Pie with foil dots chicken lips banner
 - TWO 1-7/8 x 1-7/8" pieces cut from a treat box of your choice
- **Spooky Sweet Designer Series Paper**
 - FOUR 7/8 x 1-7/8"
 - TWO 1-7/8 x 1-7/8"
- **Fresh Freesia Seam Binding Ribbon**
 - TWO about 12" each



Instructions

1. Stamp a pumpkin on a scrap of Basic White cardstock using Pumpkin Pie ink. Stamp the stem and face using Memento Tuxedo Black ink. Fussy cut then adhere it to the top of one mini Play-Doh canister using a Black Stampin' Dimensional.
2. Score, burnish with a Bone Folder, and trim the treat box according to the template photo and measurements above. Assemble the box using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
3. Score the wrapper according to the template photo and measurements above then burnish the wrapper with a Bone Folder. Use Tear & Tape Adhesive to secure, then cut the top corners with a corner rounder.
4. Round the top corners on TWO of the 7/8 x 1-7/8" pieces of designer paper. Adhere the designer series paper to TWO sides of the treat box and to the front and back segments of the wrapper.
5. Stack TWO canisters of Play-Doh, with the pumpkin on top, in the box and slide the box into the wrapper.
6. Trim the black banner from the designer paper so that it has chicken lips on the chicken lips end. Adhere the black banner to the box folding it over the top segment starting on the back. Fold and glue to fit the shape of the box. Punch a hole in the top of the wrapper using a 1/8" circle punch. See the rear view picture for reference.
7. Trim the orange dotted die cut strip with chicken lips down about 2-3/4" then adhere it to the back of the Bubble Bath "Trick or Treat" tag using a bit of liquid glue at the top and a mini black dimensional toward the bottom.
8. Glue the die cut web to the tag and then use the same 1/8" circle punch to punch through the layers at the top of the tag.
9. Adhere the pumpkin die cut to the tag using a mini black dimensional.
10. Thread the double ribbon through the hole on the tag and then through the hole in the top of the box wrap. Tie a big loopy bow.
11. Adhere the bat die cut to the bow using a Mini Glue Dot.
