## Fluffy Squirrel Acorn Box



# Measurements

- **Copper Clay Cardstock**
  - 9-3/4 x 6"
    - scored on the 6" side at 1, 2, 4 and 5"
    - scored on the 9-3/4" side at 3/4, 1-3/4, 5-1/4 and 6-1/4"
- **Very Vanilla Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting a tag using the Patterned Tags Dies
  - scrap for die cutting a tag using the Just a Note Dies
  - scrap for stamping and punching a squirrel and acorn using the Fluffy Squirrel Bundle
- **Cloud Cover Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting a 2 x 2-3/4" postage rectangle using the Perennial Postage Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the leaf sprig using the Charming Day Dies
- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting the tag reinforcer using the Patterned Tags Dies
- **Need for Tweed Designer Series Paper**
  - 1/2 x 2-1/2"
  - 1-3/4 x 3/4"
  - FOUR 7/8 x 3-3/8"
  - TWO 7/8 x 1-7/8"
  - 3-3/8 x 1-7/8"
- **Cloud Cover Faux Linen Ribbon**
  - about 10", cut in half lengthwise
- **Linen Thread**
  - about 8"

# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Copper Clay box. Trim according to the the template photo above. Assemble the box using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
2. Adhere the designer paper to each of the panels using Multipurpose Liquid Glue. Fill with treats and secure the top flap using a Velcro Dot.
3. Punch a hole in the Very Vanilla tiny tag then stamp the sentiment on the tag using Early Espresso ink. Thread the tag with Linen Thread and tie a thread knot.
4. Stamp the squirrel and acorn on a scrap of Very Vanilla cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Stamp inside the squirrel using Copper Clay or Cajun Craze ink. Color the acorn using Stampin' Blends Markers. Punch.
5. Cut some chicken lips on both ends of the 1/2" strip of designer paper using your scissors or the Tailored Tag Punch.
6. Adhere the reinforcer, leaf sprig and designer papers to the front of the tag using liquid glue.
7. Cut the postage rectangle in half and adhere it to the back of the tag using the same adhesive.
8. Adhere the squirrel to the tag using Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Adhere the tag to the box using more of the same adhesive.
10. Tie a big loopy double bow using the divided Cloud Cover ribbon. Adhere it to the box using a Mini Glue Dot or hot glue.
11. Adhere the tag and acorn using a combination of Stampin' Dimensional and Mini Glue Dots or a bit more hot glue.
