# Measurements

- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
  - 8-1/2 x 5-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
  - 3-3/4 x 5"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting a tag using the Pattern Tags Dies
  - scrap for stamping and die cutting the chicken and haystack using the Tractor & Co Bundle
  - scrap for die cutting the short narrow banner using the Stylish Shapes Dies
- **Darling Duckling Cardstock**
  - scrap for punching a flower using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
  - scrap for die cutting a tag reinforcer using the Pattern Tags Dies
  - 1/2" circle
- **Floral Impressions Designer Series Paper**
  - 3/4 x 5-1/4"
  - 1-3/4 x 5-1/4"
  - 1 x 3-1/2"
  - 1/2 x 4"
- **Linen Thread**
  - about 10"



# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Crumb Cake card base.
2. Emboss the Crumb Cake panel using the Gathering Leaves Embossing Folder. Lightly ink the embossed image using a Pecan Pie ink pad.
3. Adhere the Crumb Cake panel to the card front, followed by the designer paper and tag with reinforcer using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Stamp the the haystack using Darling Duckling ink on the scrap of Basic White cardstock.
5. Stamp the chicken on the same scrap using Pecan Pie ink. Color the comb using a Real Red Stampin' Write Marker, the beak using a Darling Duckling Stampin' Write Marker and dot an eye using an Early Espresso Stampin' Write Marker. Die cut the images.
6. Stamp "HAY" on the white banner using Early Espresso ink.
7. Adhere the banner and the haystack to the card using liquid glue.
8. Adhere the chicken to the card using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
9. Shape the flower using the capped putty end of the Take Your Pick Tool and a Stampin' Pierce Mat. Pop the Early Espresso 1/2" circle on to the flower using a Black Stampin' Dimensional then adhere the flower to the card using a Mini Glue Dot.
10. Make a bow using the Linen Thread and adhere it to the tag using a Mini Glue Dot.
11. Embellish using Purple Adhesive-Backed Sequins.
