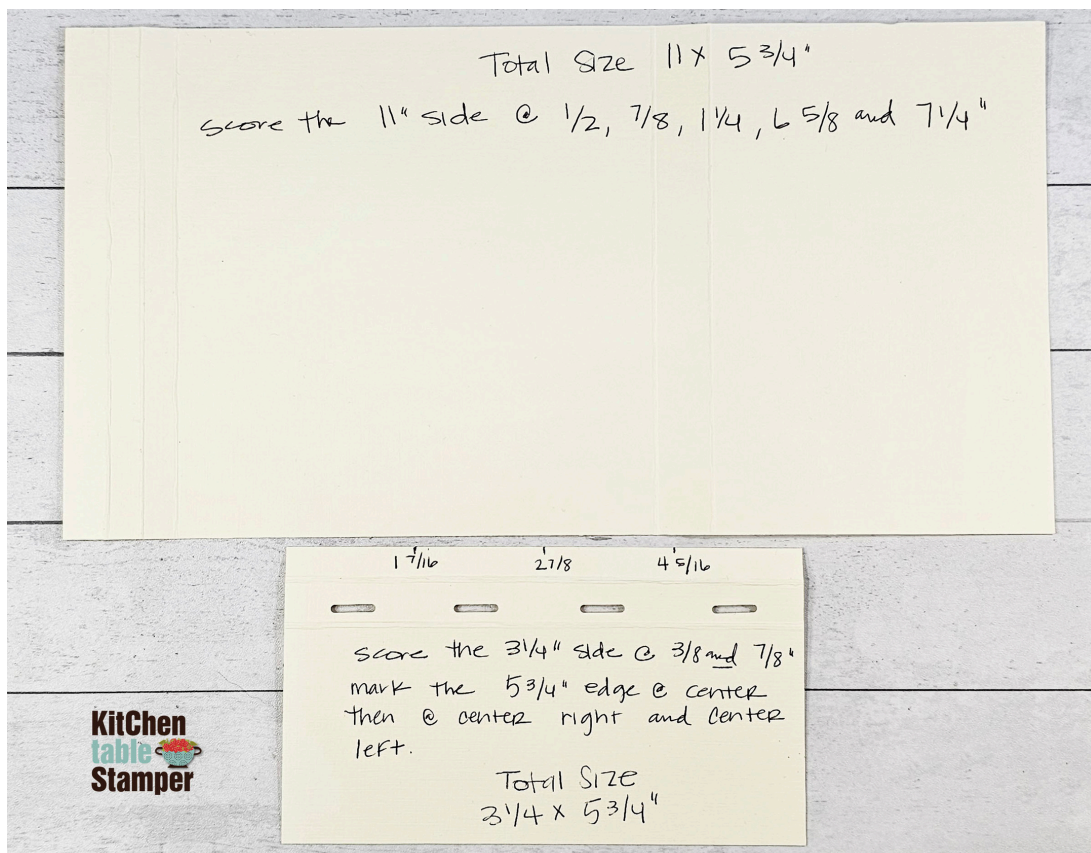

# Measurements

- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
  - 5-3/4 x 11"
    - scored on the 11" side at 1/2, 7/8, 1-1/4, 6-5/8, and 7-1/4"
  - 5-3/4 x 3-1/4"
    - scored on the the 3-1/4" side at 3/8 and 7/8"
    - mark the 5-3/4" edge at 1-7/16, 2-7/8 and 4-5/16"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
  - 2-1/2 x 3/4"
  - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the llama and scarf using the Long Time No See Stamp Set
  - scrap for die cutting the 2 x 3-1/4" arch using Everyday Arches Dies
  - scrap for die cutting the 2-3/4 x 2" postage rectangle using Perennial Postage Dies
- **Cherry Cobbler Cardstock**
  - scrap for punching the arrow banner using the Three Banner Punch
- **Christmas Tags & More Specialty Designer Series Paper**
  - THREE 5-5/8 x 2-1/4"
  - 5-5/8 x 1-3/4"
  - 5-5/8 x 1-1/2"
  - 5-5/8 x 3
  - TWO ephemera selections & ONE banner of choice
- **Shiny Red Ribbon**
  - about 24"
- **Early Espresso & Old Olive Linen Thread**
  - about 12"



# Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish both pieces of the Crumb Cake cardstock according to the template picture above. Mark the 5-3/4" edge of the 3-1/4 x 5-3/4" piece and then slots centered between the marks using the slot punch from the Hole Punch Assortment Punch Bundle. Put the edge of the paper as far as it will go with each punch to assure that your slots will line up in a neat horizontal row.
2. Using Tear & Tape Adhesive to adhere the two pieces of the portfolio. Apply the tape along the score line on the first 1/2" segment of the 11 x 5-3/4" piece. Adhere the unpunched edge of the 3-1/4 x 5-3/4" matching up the 5-3/4" sides to make a continuous strip.
3. Adhere the designer paper to the front and inside of the portfolio using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Use more Tear & Tape Adhesive to complete the portfolio pocket. Apply the tape along the score line on the last 3/8" segment next to the segment with the slots. Fold the portfolio up and adhere the 3/8" segment to the inside back cover of the portfolio.
5. Wrap the red ribbon around the front flap of the portfolio and make a bow.
6. Stamp the sentiment on the 2-1/2 x 3/4" piece of white cardstock using Cherry Cobbler ink.
7. Fold the Cherry Cobbler arrow over the right side of the greeting piece and adhere using liquid glue. Punch a hole using a 1/8" circle punch through the center of the arrow making a tag.
8. Stamp the inside greeting on the 2-3/4 x 2" postage stamp using Real Red ink.
9. Stamp the llama and scarf on a scrap of white cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Fussy cut.
10. Thread the Early Espresso Linen Thread through the Cherry Cobbler arrow on the outside greeting tag. Thread the Early Espresso Linen Thread under the center of the shiny red bow. Tie the tag to the bow and then secure the tag using Stampin' Dimensionals.
11. Adhere the llama, inside greeting and the ephemera pieces using a combination of liquid glue and Stampin' Dimensionals.
12. Embellish using Streaked Dots.
13. Tie the scarves around the llama's necks securing each scarf in place using a Mini Glue Dot.
14. Place the llama lollipops in the slots and then adhere each llama to the back cover using a Mini Glue Dot.
