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Gathering Moments Cracker Box






Measurements

- **Early Espresso Cardstock**
 - 8-1/2 x 6-1/2"
 - scored on the 8-1/2" side at 1-1/2, 2, 2-1/2, 6, 6-1/2 and 7"
 - scored on the 6-1/2" side at 1-1/2, 3, 4-1/2 and 6"
- **Very Vanilla Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting three leaves and an acorn using the Gathering Moments Bundle
 - scrap for die cutting a long wide banner using the Stylish Shapes Dies
- **Weekend Adventures Designer Series Paper**
 - FOUR 6-1/8 x 1-3/8", each strip cut down to TWO 1-3/8" squares and ONE 1-3/8 x 3-3/8" rectangle
 - IMPORTANT: for an uninterrupted pattern, cut 1-3/8" off of each end of the strip

- **Basic Beige Classic Ribbon**
 - TWO about 20" each
- **Early Espresso & Old Olive Linen Thread**
 - about 8"



Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the treat box.
 - a. When cutting the diamond shape cut outs, start with the 1/2" section folded toward you.
 - b. Cut through the folded cardstock from the first vertical score line on the left up to the second vertical score line. Then cut back down from the second vertical score line to the third vertical score line. You will cut a triangle but when you unfold it will be a diamond shape.
 - i. Be sure not to cut all the way through the 1/2" section, keep a border so the edge of the paper is in tact.
 - c. Once you have made the second triangle cut on the first horizontal score line unfold and move on to the next horizontal score line.
 - i. Fold on the next horizontal score line and repeat trimming.
 - d. Repeat for each score line. When you get to the other side of the paper trim triangles without folding the paper. See the template photo above.
2. Cut your designer series paper and adhere to each section of the cracker box.
3. Assemble the box using Tear & Tape Adhesive then close one end of the box using Basic Beige Ribbon. Fill the box with treats and close the other end of the box using the same ribbon.
4. Stamp the greeting on the banner using Early Espresso ink. Adhere the the greeting to the box using Stampin' Dimensionals.
5. Stamp the leaves on Very Vanilla cardstock using Crushed Curry, Old Olive and Pumpkin Pie ink. Stamp the acorn on the same scrap of Very Vanilla cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Die cut the leaves and acorn. Adhere the leaves and acorn to the box using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Tie a tiny Early Espresso Linen Thread bow and adhere it to the box using a Mini Glue Dot.
7. Embellish using the gold Traditional Sparkling Sequins.
