Measurements

- **Crumb Cake Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - 2-1/2 x 3/4"
 - scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the llama using the Long Time No See stamp set
 - scrap for die cutting the 2 x 3-1/4" arch using the Everyday Arches Dies
- **Cherry Cobbler Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching the arrow using the Three Banner Punch
- **Christmas Tags & More Designer Series Paper**
 - 4-1/4 x 2-1/4"
 - 1-3/4 x 5-1/4"
 - banner and embellishment punch out of your choice from the ephemera pages
- **Early Espresso Linen Thread**
 - about 9"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Crumb Cake card base. Emboss the card front using the Beautiful Pattern Embossing Folder.
2. Adhere the designer paper, the white die cut arch and the banner of your choice from the ephemera pages using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the llama on a scrap of white cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Color using Stampin' Blends. Fussy cut.
4. Stamp the greeting on the left side of the 2-1/2 x 3/4" piece of white cardstock using Cherry Cobbler ink. Adhere the Cherry Cobbler arrow to the right of the greeting using liquid glue, trim off the excess.
5. Make a bow using the Early Espresso Linen Thread. Adhere it to the greeting panel using a Mini Glue Dot then staple through using a Tiny Attacher Mini Stapler.
6. Adhere the greeting using liquid glue.
7. Adhere the llama to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals. Adhere the punch out embellishment of your choice from the ephemera pages using the same adhesive.
8. Embellish with Streaked Dots.
