Measurements

- **Gray Granite Cardstock**
 - 5-1/2 x 8-1/2", scored at 4-1/4"
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for stamping and die cutting the big bread tag using the Paper Tags Bundle
- **Petal Pink Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching a small and medium flower using the Petal Park Builder Punch
- **Old Olive Cardstock**
 - scrap for punching a leaf sprig using the Bough Builder Punch
- **Autumn Toile Designer Series Paper**
 - 3-3/4 x 2"
 - 3-3/4 x 1-1/2"
 - 4-7/8 x 1-1/4"
- **Old Olive & Early Espresso Linen Thread**
 - about 18"

Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the Gray Granite card base. Stamp leaves on the card front using the Gray Granite ink.
2. Adhere the designer papers to the card using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
3. Stamp the tag on a scrap of Basic White cardstock using Early Espresso ink. For the darkest and most solid image, use a stamp positioner. Ink the stamp, stamp then ink again and stamp again without moving the cardstock.
4. Die cut the tag and adhere it to the card using liquid glue.
5. Shape the flowers using the capped putty end of the Take Your Pick Tool and a Stampin' Pierce Mat. Layer the smaller flower onto the medium flower and assemble using a Mini Glue Dot. Adhere the flower and leaf sprig to the card using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
6. Make a double bow using Early Espresso Linen Thread and adhere it to the card using a Mini Glue Dot.
7. Embellish using Streaked Dots and Brushed Brass Butterflies.
