

Measurements

- **Shaded Spruce Cardstock**
 - 4-7/16" square
 - scored on all four sides at 1-1/2"
- **Elegant Pine Snowflakes Designer Series Paper**
 - 6-1/2 x 2-1/2"
 - scored on the 6-1/2" side at 1-1/2, 3, 4-1/2, and 6"
 - scored on the 2-1/2" side at 1-1/4 and 2"
- **Basic Beige Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the two leaf sprig using the Charming Day Dies
 - scrap for die cutting the postage end label using the Perennial Postage Dies
- **Basic White Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a pine bough using the Branching Out Dies
- **Cherry Cobbler Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting the stitched heart using the Valentine Kisses Dies
- **Pecan Pie Cardstock**
 - scrap for die cutting a pinecone using the Branching Out Dies
- **Early Espresso Linen Thread**
 - about 8"



Instructions

1. Score, fold, and burnish the box and lid. Trim according to the template photo above. Assemble the box and lid using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
2. Form the milk carton lid by pinching the top together, gusset folding the sides in while popping out the bottom. Staple the top of the milk carton lid so that the smooth side of the staple is to the back of the box. NOTE: If you are making the lid from cardstock you will want to score the gussets before folding.
3. Stamp the greeting on the Basic Beige label using Early Espresso ink.
4. Color the Basic White pine bough and Basic Beige leaves using Shaded Spruce, Pecan Pie and Old Olive Stampin' Blends.
5. Adhere the colored pine bough to the lid using a sandwich of Stampin' Dimensionals, then adhere the greeting label to the lid using the same adhesive.
6. Adhere the heart and pinecone to the box using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
7. Tuck the leaves behind the heart and secure them with a Mini Glue Dot.
8. Tie a bow using Early Espresso Linen Thread. Adhere to the box using a Mini Glue Dot.
9. Pop a treat into the box and apply the lid. Your treat can be anything as long as it is smaller than 1-1/2 x 1-1/2 x 2". The box lid can be snugged down like for the Lindt truffle or sit higher for a taller treat like the mini Mentos gum.
