- Hole Punch Assortment - 165409
- Modern Christmas 12" X 12" Specialty Designer Series Paper - 165990
- Basic Black Cardstock - 121045
- Basic White Cardstock - 166780
- Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad - 132708
- Cherry Cobbler Stampin' Pad - 147083
- Garden Green Stampin' Pad - 147089
- Gold Striped 3/8" Mesh Ribbon - 165599

# Measurements

- **Basic Black Cardstock**

- 4-1/2 x 9"
  - scored on the 4-1/2" side at 1, 2, 3 and 4"
  - scored on the 9" side at 1, 7, 7-1/2 and 8"
- scrap for die cutting the 1 x 2-1/4" arch using Everyday Arches

- **Basic White Cardstock**

- scrap for die cutting the 1 x 2-1/4" arch using Everyday Arches
- scrap for stamping and fussy cutting the holly leaves and berries using the Keeping Traditions stamp set

- **Modern Christmas Designer Series Paper**

- FOUR 7/8 x 5-7/8"
- FIVE 7/8 x 7/8"
  - IMPORTANT: for an uninterrupted pattern, keep cut pieces in order for continuity when adhering

- **Gold Striped 3/8" Mesh Ribbon**

- about 15"

- **Baker's Twine Essentials Pack**

- about 8"



## Instructions

1. Score, fold and burnish the treat box.
  - a. When cutting the diamond shape cut outs, hold the 9" side toward you and start with the 1/2" section folded down.
  - b. Cut through the folded cardstock from the second vertical score line on the left up to the third vertical score line. Then cut back down from the third vertical score line to the fourth vertical score line. You will cut a triangle but when you unfold it will be a diamond shape. Be sure not to cut all the way through the 1/2" section, keep a border so the edge of the paper is in tact.
  - c. Once you have made the triangle cut on the first horizontal score line unfold and move on to the next horizontal score line.
    - i. Fold on the next horizontal score line and repeat trimming.
  - d. Repeat folding and trimming for each horizontal score line. When you get to the other side of the paper trim a triangle without folding the paper.
2. Assemble the box using Tear & Tape Adhesive.
3. Cut your designer series paper and adhere to each section of the modified cracker box using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
4. Fill the box with treats and close the fancy cracker end of the box using ribbon.
5. Stamp the greeting on the Basic White arch using Tuxedo Black Memento ink. Layer it offset with the matching Basic Black arch using Liquid Glue. Allow to dry a bit then punch a hole in the arch using the 1/8" circle from the Hole Punch Assortment.
6. Thread the tag with some black bakers twine. Tie the tag to the bow at the fancy end of the modified cracker box. Tie a thread knot to secure the tag, then further secure the tag using a Mini Stampin' Dimensional to adhere the tag to the box.
7. Stamp the holly on Basic White cardstock using Garden Green ink. Stamp the berries on the same scrap of Basic White cardstock using Cherry Cobble ink. Fussy cut the holly and berries. Adhere the holly and berries to the tag using a combination of Mini Glue Dots and Stampin' Dimensionals.
